IFB would like to take this opportunity to thank you for participating at the Toronto Spring Summit on May 27 & 28 at the Toronto Congress Centre. We are proud to say that it was our most successful event yet, with a record high attendance! Furthermore, the response from Delegates was overwhelmingly positive.

Throughout the Summit, we asked Delegates to provide us with feedback on the event. As part of their evaluations, they were asked to rate the sessions they attended in terms of both Content and Presentation.

As usual, we want to share with you the positive feedback that we received. It is important to note that not all Delegates responded. For your particular sessions, a total of 134 out of 597 Delegates completed our survey. Below is a breakdown of the results for each of your presentations:

Presentation: 81%

Content: 90%

Presentation: 91%

In addition to providing feedback on the presentations, we also asked Delegates for general feedback on the event itself. Of those who responded, over 75% rated the IFB Spring Summit as 'somewhat' or 'significantly' better than similar events they had attended in the past. Similarly, over 90% of respondents said that they were planning on attending future IFB Summits.
